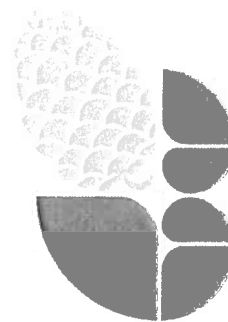

### PE Kit

We are delighted to inform you that from next week **commencing 17 September**, children will now have two PE sessions per week. They will have their normal PE session with Mr Holmes as well as a session with their class teacher. Their class teachers will be focusing particularly on developing fundamental skills such as balance, agility and co-ordination which will help to set the children up to be physically literate for life.

Please find below the timetable for various year groups. This is subject to change on a weekly basis due to weather or other circumstances (parents will always be advised by text message if this is the case).

\*Year 3 will start their second PE session once their swimming sessions have finished.

If possible children should have two PE shirts, one to wear on each day, but if not please ensure they have an appropriate t-shirt for both their PE days (not Football shirts). For clubs children may wear other sports clothes such as football tops.

Children will need to have available: Trainers that are suitable for wet field conditions and trainers that are suitable for indoors (they could be the same pair), shorts and tracksuit bottoms, appropriate t-shirt and warm top and **should not wear jewellery on either of their PE days. Please provide a spare dry pair of socks in case their feet get wet on the field.** Year Reception will be in the hall for all their lessons for now. Please send a note in to Mr Holmes if you have a concern with any of the above.

Children are asked to take their PE kit home with them each day in order to minimise losses and keep the school tidy. They should bring their kit in with them on their PE day as well as any day they wish to participate in a lunchtime or after school club. Thank you in advance for your help and support with the new timetable and for ensuring your child arrives at school with the correct kit,
